

the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before an entry can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be treated as non-competitor.

Be aware of the risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to exhibitors and do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

Now please take a moment to consider whether the route to the Show is on a busy road. Please try to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If you are not well conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the Show is a good idea at all. If you do go, ensure your dog is fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of shade.

Avoid sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog. Do not leave your dog in the vehicle.

Always take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid any part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended periods.

Your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to health problems after your dogs welfare.

**NO DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE MADE WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

Anyone entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the health and welfare of the dog, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, or negligence.

For more regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under the rules to refuse any entry.

Entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry book and Kennel Club registered.

The entry is the sole and unconditional property of the Exhibitor in whose name they are entered and will be closed.

Entries will be final except in the case of fraud or misrepresentation or where a bona fide mistake has been made. No alteration of the awards may be made after the day of the Show without the approval of the Kennel Club [vide KCSR 32k]

If you are unable to attend from fulfilling his/her engagements, the Committee reserve the right of appointment and exhibitors may withdraw from competition, but no entry fees can be refunded.

It is the responsibility of exhibitors for ensuring that their dogs are available when required for judging. If a dog is not available, the Committee will not be responsible for its absence from the ring.

Any infringement of this regulation will be reported to the Kennel Club and will take such action as is seen fit.

The Show must compensate and/or indemnify the Society for any loss or negligence by exhibitors or anyone of 18 who is brought by them to the Show for whom they are responsible.

Conditions must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/ or at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations or disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.

Dogs found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award given at the show.

If the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further disciplinary action either a fine or as listed under Rule 42.

Any substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat or any part of the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. Any substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be used for any purpose at any time during the Show.

Any substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any part of the dog at the time of exhibition.

Any operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part of the dog may be performed except :-

1. Operations not certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.

2. Removal of dew-claws of any breed.

3. Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the General Committee before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done to alter the appearance of the dog in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.

4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a qualified veterinary executive authority who shall have a written directive from the General Committee in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination.

5. Any exhibitor has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the General Committee. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection to the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The General Committee or the Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made.

6. Any complaint by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of the complaint.
